



Treasurer Report

How PTL funds are raised and what do they cover?

- PTL funds are raised via annual dues, time and talent buyouts, and through fundraisers.
- PTL monies are for the benefit of our teachers, our students, events, field trips, and our facilities.









Annual Budget and Expenditures



• For the 20-21 school year, there are approved budgeted expenses of \$24,289.00 which requires we raise revenues based on a budget of \$25,876.67 minimum to result in income of \$23,289.00 after a 10% tithe to the Church.

Time and Talent

What counts toward completion of Time and Talent Hours?

- Teacher support: memory, reading, grading, centers, copies/collating, cutting out papers, field trip driver/chaperone, etc. (many of these activities can be done at home)
- SCRIP assistance

• Library assistance

Office assistance

School bulletin boards or electronic postings

- Special events during the school day
- Teacher Appreciation and Lutheran Schools Week (decorating, planning, and other activities requested by the PTL)
- Set-up/clean-up of school or PTL events: Field Day, Back-To-School BBQ, Walk-a-Thon, Flower Sale, etc. (opportunities will be made available via Sign-Up Genius)
- Support other PTL-sponsored activities and fundraisers (opportunities will be made available via Sign-Up Genius)
- Head coaching: JV/Varsity sports, drama, chess, or other clubs (counts for a maximum of 5 hours)
- Serving as room parent (counts for a maximum of 5 hours)









What does NOT count toward completion of Time and Talent Hours?



- Time and Talent hours are earned by volunteering for activities that are general school events or PTL functions.
- If the function is an <u>elective</u> program (i.e. sporting event, before/after school clubs such as drama, scouts, German club, etc.) then the hours spent supporting these functions would NOT count toward Time and Talent
 - (The exception to this rule would be <u>head</u> coaching sports teams or clubs.)
- Hosting a trunk for Trunk-or-Treat does NOT count toward Time and Talent hours.









How do I Check my Time and Talent Balance?

- Time and Talent balances are recorded and reported in RenWeb at the end of each academic quarter.
- Deadlines are published in the Lambs Connection.
- Instructions for checking/paying off your Time and Talent balance can be found on RenWeb under Resource Documents.
 - The file is entitled "PTL Service Hour Payment Instructions"









How do I Report my Time and Talent Hours?

- The link to the Google form for reporting Time and Talent hours for the 2020-2021 school year is https://bit.ly/3ahxB27 Please file a report when hours are served. Renweb will be updated Quarterly.
- Deadlines:
 - 1st Quarter Thursday, Oct. 29, 2020
 - 2nd Quarter Thursday, January 14, 2021
 - 3rd Quarter Thursday, March 18, 2021
 - Final deadline Friday, May 21, 2021

The last day for reporting Time and Talent hours will be Friday, May 21, 2021. Final balances will be updated in RenWeb by Wednesday, May 26, 2021. We kindly request that any balances be paid in full by Wednesday, June 2 to help the office with closing out accounts before the end of the year.
